E. M. MAXIMUS broke inwards bumping at the start, was collected to track the leaders along the inside early, shifted out nearing the turn, made steady progress splitting foes on the bend, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and continued with a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. MONGOL BULL, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, switched outside the pacesetter racing through the turn while being urged to terms with that foe nearing upper stretch, gained the advantage entering the lane but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. IT'S A BAD RAPIT, bumped by the eventual winner, then shuffled back at the start, tracked the leaders along the inside, came around a tiring foe racing into the stretch and continued willingly inside foes to the end to earn a share. KEEP ON SHINING settled into stride off the inside in the opening stages, angled nearer to the inside on the turn and made some steady late progress inside foes to improve position. J C FIFTY exchanged bumps, then was squeezed back at the start, settled into stride, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress in that path late. T J'S SLEW P exchanged bumps at the start with J C FIFTY, was urged through close quarters to secure the lead, shifted to the inside racing into the bend dictating the pace on a clear margin but gave out leaving midstretch. BAJAN RHYTHM was a brief factor four deep pursuing the leaders into the turn but gave way early. DESERT DEW was guided to the inside early while gaining a forward placing but steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
