BIG TIME LUCK raced off the rail near the middle of the field, came four wide into the stretch, rallied to the lead and drew off. RUBY LIGHT raced close up off the rail, came into the stretch inside the winner and match strides with that one to the furlong marked but was not good enough late. DON'TIMPRESSMEMUCH vied for the lead inside and took over on the turn but could not last. DANCING TAYLOR lacked speed and rallied mildly late. BLUSHING CALLER was never a factor. CHASTITY was always outrun. BAILADORA vied for the lead just outside and tired. LAURENE'S GHOST was fractious in the gate, saved ground and tired.
