Footnotes

SNAKE RIVER CANYON broke sharply, moved clear of his foes along the inside dictating the tempo, held sway on a clear margin to upper stretch, then widened his advantage to the end under brisk handling. UNPAID CRUSADE tracked the pacesetter as part of the second flight near the inside to the backstretch, shifted off the inside to briefly challenge the leader on the second bend, couldn't match that foe in the drive but proved clearly best of the others. PAISANO CREEK was settled along the inside from well out of striking distance early, saved ground on the second bend, then came around a tiring foe to improve his placing in late stages. SOLO CAT tracked off the second flight along the rail racing into the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. TOM ARCHDEACON tracked off the second flight while three deep in the opening stages, continued off the inside to the second bend but never gained striking distance. FLY'N LION tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight into the backstretch but steadily faded after a half. VOY POR UNO MAS, caught four wide racing into the first turn, tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight to the far turn and dropped out nearing upper stretch.
