### Footnotes

TILDEN LANE held up stalking the pacesetter along the inside racing into the backstretch, continued unhurried saving ground on the second bend, shifted off the inside entering upper stretch, angled four deep nearing the furlong marker while being urged to challenge and wrested command in time under steady hand urging. WHERE'S THE BABY was settled outside foes off the second flight in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance entering the far turn while shifting out three deep, moved to challenge for command in that path near midstretch, held a narrow advantage past the furlong marker but failed to contain the winner. DALAXY tracked off the second flight along the rail in the opening half, saved ground on the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch, angled five deep approaching the furlong marker and continued to make mild progress to the end to close the gap and gain a share. VIVA MONGOLIA took up a position three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, advanced nearing the far turn to gain terms with the pacesetter, pressed that foe through the second bend into upper stretch but gave way leaving the furlong marker. KEEP ME POSTED, pulling between foes racing off the second flight, continued under reserve when racing in close quarters midway through the backstretch and never gained striking distance while improving his position. UNORTHODOX, bumped, then forced inwards at the break, was settled off the inside racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. GRAND SILVER sped to the fore along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace into the second bend, briefly resisted a rival's challenge but gave way after his rider lost his whip in upper stretch. LAST CAT broke inwards bumping UNORTHODOX, moved to gain a position between foes in the second flight racing to the first turn but quickly retreated midway through the backstretch.
