Footnotes

RENA STARLIGHT shifted inwards just after the start clipping heels with TOUCH OF REVENGE, then bobbling, was settled into stride outside foes from just out of striking distance racing through the backstretch, steadily drew into contention while angling four wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command and pull clear late under pressure. WIDJA DIDJA came through tight quarters between foes in the opening quarter to gain a position just off the pacesetter, tracked the leader inside a rival racing into the bend, shifted out of tight quarters nearing the furlong marker making some contact with HEATED DEBATE while being urged to challenge, couldn't match strides with the winner but continued with interest to earn place honors. TOUCH OF REVENGE angled to the inside soon after the start while being urged to dispute the pace inside foes, shied into the path of DIRECT BREEZE racing through the gap, was urged to gain a clear advantage on the backstretch, set the pace into upper stretch, failed to sustain her momentum through the final sixteenth, then ducked inwards brushing the rail while giving way nearing the wire. HEATED DEBATE broke readily to gain a forward placing, was urged along three deep racing through the backstretch in pursuit of the pacesetter, was bumped nearing midstretch and lacked the needed final response. LEWDERHOO, held up just out of striking distance while shifting to the inside racing through the backstretch, couldn't produce the needed closing response. DIRECT BREEZE, forced inwards a bit at the gap, trailed throughout.
