TURTLE PIE was urged along to gain a position off the first flight near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch while making steady progress, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and edged clear through the last furlong under firm encouragement. DIXIE'S BACK shied inwards at the start bumping BATTLE BUSTER, was righted while guided to the inside to track off the second flight racing into the bend, shifted out to bid between foes in close quarters nearing midstretch, then switched out four deep in late stages to gain the place honors. OFF THE LEASH tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, split foes then angled out five wide racing into upper stretch but continued willingly in that path to earn a share. KIKI CHACER was hustled outside foes to join a rival on the pace, pressed that foe on the turn to upper stretch but weakened once headed by the winner late. BATTLE BUSTER, bumped at the start, was settled in hand outside a rival in the last flight racing to the bend and never gained contention. MARYJEAN stumbled badly a the start losing position to the field and never menaced thereafter. THRILL MAKER tracked off the first flight a bit off the inside in the opening stages, shifted out four wide racing through the turn while under some prompting to advance but quickly faded after a half. SISTER JESSIE sped to the lead along the inside from the break, dueled for command along the rail racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch.
