Original nominees to pay \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the winner; \$30,000 to second; \$16,500 to third; \$9,000 to fourth and \$4,500 to fifth. WEIGHTS: Sunday, August 28, 2005. This event will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference will be Highweights (on the scale). Total Earnings in 2005 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees with the exception of the nominating fee(s). Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. INDY GROOVE maintained a short lead from off the rail, set all of the pace while pressed and proved superior in the drive while kept to her task. QUICK TEMPER was allowed to settle off the rail while not far back, responded to urging in the stretch and gained the place while no threat to the winner. DIAVLA broke slowly and lacked speed, angled to the middle of the track for the drive and closed a gap for minor awards. FOR GILLIAN raced inside near the middle of the field and made a bid in the stretch but faltered late. KRISTY BEETHOVEN was void of speed and improved her position without threatening. SILENT SIREN raced off the rail near the middle of field and weakened. MISS TERRIBLE (ARG) pressed the pace of the winner from the rail and stopped badly in the drive.
