CATCHING set the pace from the inside and held sway in the drive under urging. PENELOPE WONDERS raced close up inside and rallied late but missed. CELESTIAL ART raced off the rail near the middle of the field, came four wide into the stretch and gained belatedly. RIC RAC lacked speed three wide and made a bid on the final turn but faltered. LIKE MY DAD lacked speed off the rail and was never a factor. MONKEY DUST was carried out on the first turn, raced close up off the rail and gave way. MOLLY MULHOLLUN was through early. (Race run in lane 1, rail at 0.)
