WULFGAR was urged to secure the lead while being guided nearer the inside in the opening quarter, set the pace on a narrow margin into the bend, then responded when roused to forge clear in upper stretch, widening his advantage to the end under pressure. SUDDEN INTEREST, forwardly placed near the inside in the opening stages, stalked just off the pacesetter racing to the turn, bid between foes nearing upper stretch but proved no match. NDONGO, reserved four wide just off the second flight in the opening stages, advanced on the turn to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. SIGNSEALNDELIVER tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the turn but lacked the needed closing bid. LIBERATOR EXPRESS, unhurried along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground while making some progress to gain striking distance after six furlongs but had no final response. FIJI STAR (ARG) tracking near the inside in the opening stages, swerved in sharply at the gap leaving the seven furlong marker and never regained contention.
