Footnotes

TUCKY tracked the leaders in second flight between foes, made a steady advance in tandem with MUSTANG POWDER leaving the far turn to challenge for command and edged clear of that foe late under firm encouragement. The latter secured position near the inside leading the second flight into the backstretch, steadily closed the gap on the pacesetter to gain brief command in upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner. MIAMI ICE tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside behind the second flight, angled off the inside leaving the far turn, raced in some traffic near midstretch but made steady

progress to earn a share. IRON CHAMP, bumped at the start, was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch, then steadily improved his position racing into the stretch. WISTFUL SMILE tracked the pace between foes off the second flight to the far turn, shifted out four wide leaving the far turn and continued evenly into the stretch. GAMBLERS REWARD, unhurried outside foes in the second flight, raced four wide through the backstretch and offered no rally. SON OF TIGER was urged well clear of his foes into the backstretch, held sway on a commanding margin into the far turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch. MING GLO, broke inwards bumping IRON CHAMP, was caught five wide racing into the first turn and never gained contention. JUMP RIGHT IN, came around foes on the first turn to gain second racing to the backstretch, chased the pacesetter into the far turn and dropped out after six furlongs while failing to gain terms with the pacesetter. EASY was never a factor. ALLOW was soon outdistanced, then walked off the course under his own power.
