CAVALERO, caught a bit wide while being reserved off the second flight racing into the turn, continued under reserve outside a rival from out of striking distance to the second bend, steadily advanced to contention while shifting out leaving the far turn, was carried out six wide by MELDRICK nearing upper stretch but continued with a steady late response to wrest command and draw clear late under strong handling. MELDRICK, held up just off the second flight racing to the backstretch, angled outside foes advancing to striking distance four deep on the far turn, shifted out five wide nearing upper stretch, couldn't match the winner's kick but drew on even terms with a rival to share place honors on the wire. VOUCH FOR VICTORY, forwardly placed from the outset, attended a rival's pace to the backstretch, pressed the issue into the second bend, shook clear racing into upper stretch but just failed to fend off the

winner then finished on even terms with a rival for second. TABLE GAMES, held up along the rail in the second flight to the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch, then came through close quarters in late stages while continuing willingly along the rail to the end. E. BLUE, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued to late stages with a mild bid. ISTHMUS moved to gain a position in the second flight racing to the first turn, angled to the inside after a half, shifted out to make a brief bid between foes entering upper stretch but flattened out in late stages. TERMINAL ONE, urged to the fore along the rail in the opening stages, disputed the pace into the second bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. MR MOJO RISIN, reserved near the inside in the opening half, drew into contention along the inside entering upper stretch, but was steadied when blocked nearing the furlong marker while losing all momentum. RAFE broke outwards bumping NOW I'M MAD, was pulling his rider along racing to the first turn while shifting outside foes, was caught wide racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid three deep nearing the far turn but quickly emptied out. NOW I'M MAD, bumped at the start, trailed throughout.
