Footnotes

MAGIC MAN, a step slow into stride, raced unhurried from out of striking distance a bit off the inside racing into the bend, shifted outside foes nearing upper stretch gathering momentum, angled seven deep in upper stretch and was roused to wrest command and kick clear in time. WINNING WILDCAT, six deep in the opening stages, continued under reserve outside foes off the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out six wide advancing six deep entering upper stretch, moved to challenge between foes in that path past midstretch and was just outfinished. TERRIFIC TIM, five deep between foes in the opening stages, angled inwards to track outside foes in the second flight racing into the bend, shifted out five wide while moving to challenge between foes in upper

stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. GIBBY'S TORNADO broke outwards bumping CARAMALEN, was quickly righted to force the pace three wide racing into the turn, shifted out into the four path disputing the issue to midstretch but weakened in late stages. NATURDAY tracked off the second flight near the inside racing into the bend, shifted out to split foes three wide nearing midstretch but lacked the needed final kick. MILWAUKEE WOLF angled inwards racing to the turn to track the leaders between foes in the second flight but lacked the needed closing response. GREAT BAM, a bit outpaced early, angled seven wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. CITOYEN STYLE tracked the leaders along the rail from just out of striking distance, continued as part of the second flight racing through the bend but came up empty after a half. INDIAN TALK, slow into stride, never gained contention. AMAZING BUD was hustled to the lead from the break, disputed the pace along the rail through the turn, edged forward in upper stretch but emptied out abruptly leaving the furlong marker. ROAD TO WAR pressed the pace between foes racing into the turn and gave way after a half. CAMELEEN, bumped, then pinched back at the start, trailed the field to the stretch.
