A Supplementary Nomination of \$2,000 may be made on Saturday, August 27, 2011, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHTS: Sunday, August 28, 2011. This event will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference will be Highweights (on the scale). *Total Earnings in 2011 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees with the exception of the nominating fee(s). Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Trophy to the owner of the winner. MISTER MARTI GRAS, reserved outside a rival in the last flight racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance three deep racing through the far turn, angled out four wide in upper stretch while being roused to advance, closed the gap on the pacesetter leaving the furlong marker while shifting inwards a bit and narrowly prevailed in time under firm encouragement. WORKIN FOR HOPS, brushed at the start by DARK COVE, moved clear of his foes into the first turn to set the pace in hand, turned back a challenge from BURJ ALZAIN (IRE) racing through the far turn to regain a clear advantage nearing midstretch, then drifted out in the final sixteenth while just failing to contain the winner. MARISTAR, reserved saving ground in the opening half, came around a tiring foe on the far turn to advance to contention along the inside racing through upper stretch, shifted out leaving the furlong marker to bid three deep between foes and was steadied out of tight quarters nearing the wire when losing her path. BURJ ALZAIN (IRE), urged to secure a forward placing inside the pacesetter in the opening stages, shifted outside that foe nearing the backstretch to stalk that rival under some reserve, moved to force the issue nearing the midway point of the far turn, couldn't match terms with the pacesetter in the final three sixteenths of a mile but continued evenly to late stages. COLOR ME BLUE broke outwards bumping DARK COVE at the break, was reserved along the inside as part of the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch while being roused to challenge but lacked the needed final bid. DARK COVE, hopped, then was bumped at the start, was reserved just off the second flight between foes to the backstretch, was roused to advance leaving the midway point of the far turn but lacked a closing response. GENERAL QUARTERS, reserved three deep racing as part of the second flight in the opening half, made a brief advance in tandem with a rival nearing the far turn but came up empty approaching the quarter mile marker. HOOSIER KINGDOM was a brief factor tracking just off the leaders between foes racing to the backstretch but quickly retreated from contention after a half. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF MARISTAR LODGED A

CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDERS OF WORKIN FOR HOPS AND MISTER MARTIS GRAS FOR INTERFERENCE. THE STEWARDS REVIEWED THE INCIDENT IN LATE STRETCH AND DISQUALIFIED WORKIN FOR HOPS FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM THIRD.
