Footnotes

NIKKI'S SANDCASTLE, pulled his way between foes in the opening stages to gain terms with a rival on the pace racing into the first turn, moved clear entering the backstretch, dictated the pace on a clear margin through the second bend and held sway to the end under firm handling. CHARGING HOME, held up between foes in the second flight in the opening half, shifted outside foes racing through the far turn to challenge four wide in upper stretch but proved only second best. CANTONIC broke inwards bumping PHOTO SHOOT, was guided to the rail while securing a forward placing, relinquished the lead to a rival nearing the backstretch to stalk that foe along the inside, shifted out racing through the far turn while advancing to striking position, but couldn't match terms with the top pair in last stages while narrowly prevailing for a share. ALBIN settled into stride in the last flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, split foes three deep advancing on the far turn, angled out five wide in upper stretch and continued to make belated progress to the end while just missing for third. PHOTO SHOOT, bumped at the break, was reserved off the second flight near the inside to the backstretch, shifted out entering upper stretch and split foes three deep while making an effort to improve his placing. ZOEBEAR, held up just off the leaders along the rail in second flight racing to the far turn, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch to bid between foes but had no final response. SAINT BREES, reserved near the inside in

the last flight racing to the second bend, shifted outside foes on the far turn, angled six wide entering upper stretch but could make little impression on the leaders. FAPTITUDE, reserved along the inside well off the second flight racing to the far turn, lacked a closing response. I AM THE SHERIFF was guided to the rail early, saved ground throughout but never menaced. KING ROOTIN TOOTIN, forwardly placed three deep racing into the first turn, tracked the leader outside foes in the second flight in that path to the far turn but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. MR. MISCHIEF settled outside foes off the second flight early, was caught five wide racing through the far turn and soon dropped out of contention. AWESOMO angled inwards to track the leaders between foes off the second flight racing to the far turn, couldn't gain contention and steadily faded in the drive.
