ADORATION broke in good order, quickly established the lead from the inside, was shown the whip to draw off in upper stretch then finished under a brisk hand ride. TAMWEEL went up to press the pace from just outside, remained lapped on the winner to the stretch then could not stay with that one in the final furlong and settled for the place. INDY GROOVE was taken back after breaking alertly, raced four to five wide, near the middle of the field, launched a bid in upper stretch then could not rally late. JULIE'S PRIZE lacked speed three to four wide then rallied mildly in the stretch but could not sustain her bid. BARE NECESSITIES lacked speed four to five wide and was never prominent. ALLSPICE raced close up three to four wide and tired. HENNIE'S SONG raced close up inside and steadily lost ground.
