**Footnotes**

S S STEWBALL, reserved along the rail from just out of striking distance racing to the far turn, came through inside foes to challenge in upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to the end to just edge U STEP ASIDE under firm handling. The latter moved to the fore along the inside racing to the first turn, resisted when challenged on the far turn, shifted off the inside while dueling between foes racing through the stretch and resisted the winner to the end. BIG BAD MIKE, a bit rank while reserved in the last flight early, angled out four wide to split foes in upper stretch and produced his best stride late to close the gap on the top pair. CHARBOURG stalked just off the pacesetter to the backstretch, moved to press the issue into upper stretch but was outkicked in the drive. BURGAN RULES, reserved off the second flight between foes racing to the second bend, continued evenly in that path racing into the stretch. TOQUINHO, reserved along the rail to the far turn, shifted off the inside entering upper stretch, was shuffled a bit in tight quarters between foes nearing the furlong marker but continued to make mild progress. TSUNAMI KING tracked the leaders three wide off the second flight in the opening half, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. AZTEC RUN tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight under some reserve, made a brief, three wide bid nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. CLOUD CASTLE, reserved along the inside racing to the far turn, came up empty entering upper stretch.
