WEKIVA WACHEE was settled into stride along the inside in the opening stages, steadily gathered momentum on the bend, shifted out five wide carrying out MIGHTY RULE racing into upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. MIGHTY RULE, forced

inwards a bit by PETERS ROCK while shifting into the path of SOUTHERN REGION soon after the start, tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight racing into the bend, was forced out six wide by the eventual winner entering upper stretch but continued willingly outside foes to prevail for place honors late. ALL TANKED UP tracked the leaders in second flight along the rail under some reserve racing to the turn, saved ground to upper stretch, steadied a bit when advancing in close quarters nearing midstretch but continued willingly to the end to edge a rival for a share. SOUTHERN REGION, squeezed between foes soon after the start, shifted out to gain a forward placing three deep racing into the bend, continued with a steady bid to challenge for command in that path racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. PETERS ROCK broke sharply while angling to the inside, forced the pace outside a rival racing into the bend and gave way entering upper stretch. SPEIGHT THE HALO tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight to the bend but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. SILVER CRAFT, urged to dispute the pace along the rail soon after the break, gained a brief lead racing into upper stretch but emptied out leaving the furlong marker. HOLIDAY BALLAD settled between foes in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. LEROY'S PRIDE was never a factor.
