SUZY CREEK SLEW raced close up outside, came four wide into the stretch and rallied in the stretch but missed. PETITE ZINGER raced close up outside and lacked a winning bid. SPANISH SAGE had a belated bid that fell short. SIMPLY SANTA FE raced close up but weakened. PRUNE'S INTEREST was fractious behind the gate, lacked speed and steadily improved her position. FRENCH TOAST set the pace from the inside while pressed and tired. PRAYER CHAIN was never a factor. SPLASHING PRINCESS was always outrun. NURSE TYPE was through early. SWEET AND ROYAL gave way in the drive. SUE'S LEGACY raced close up inside and tired.
