SHE BE WILD was away alertly then rated off the rail, split horses and drew off in the late going. TIZ MIZ SUE was unhurried early while wide, took the lead heading for home, weakened but saved the place inside. SCREEN LEGEND made a steady advance, drifted out in the lane and was best of the rest. DECEPTIVE GLORY checked and bumped HIGHEST POWER at the top of the stretch and lacked a late response. SUZANNE had no speed, swung out widest in the turn, angled in and had some late run. THATS WHATSHESAID had a wide trip, loomed a threat but was not good enough. GABBA GIRL vied for the lead inside and faltered in the stretch. HIGHEST POWER vied for the lead off the rail, was bumped by a foe while tiring in the turn and dropped back. ATTEMPT TO NAME vied for lead between horses, was used up and gave way.
