Footnotes

LAGUNA MOON tracked the pace unhurried outside foes from out of striking distance in the opening half, came around foes on the far turn while under pressure to advance, swung five wide entering upper stretch and produced a solid late response to collar COUNCIL OAK and wrest command from that foe to prevail in time under strong handling. The latter reserved off the second flight saving ground into the backstretch, shifted out to advance three wide with a quarter mile to go, moved to brief command between calls in late stages but couldn't fend off the winner. WONKA, reserved along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out gathering momentum entering upper stretch to bid four wide between foes but was outkicked by the top pair. BAUERS GOT HOURS, buffeted between FIRE CLOUD and MISTER THAYER at the start, moved clear of those foes to gain the lead along the inside on the first turn, dictated the tempo into the second bend, turned back a challenger nearing upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the final furlong. MISTER THAYER broke outwards bumping at the start, secured position along the rail just off the leaders racing into the first turn, was pulling a bit tracking those foes in the opening half, made a brief bid near the inside when presented an opening in upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. HATTAASH was settled well off the pace racing to the far turn, raced in traffic along the inside in late stages but made no impression. FIRE CLOUD broke inwards bumping a rival, tracked the leaders outside a foe in the flight racing into the far turn but came up after six furlongs. JUSTHEGUYTODOIT stalked just off the pacesetter in hand racing to the backstretch, pressed that foe racing through the far turn and emptied out when proving no match.
