HERE COMES FRAZIER broke readily to secure terms with a rival on the pace, pulled his way to a clear advantage under rating after the opening quarter, continued in that fashion through the turn, forged clear when given his cue nearing midstretch and drew away through late stages under firm hand urging. ROJO VERDE, bumped at the start, was urged to a forward placing along the rail, tracked the pacesetter along the inside racing into the bend, couldn't menace that foe after a half but proved best of the others. OPTIONALITY, reserved off the second flight four deep early, continued to track the leaders under some reserve into the bend, angled to the inside racing into upper stretch and continued well enough to earn a share. PRINCE CHEVAL swerved inwards at the break bumping ROJO VERDE, ducked out sharply under correction crossing the path of BLACK WING, was righted, then shifted outside foes chasing the pacesetter three deep racing into the bend but came up empty entering upper stretch. SCATMAN, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter outside a rival racing into the bend, steadily weakened entering upper stretch. ETAR broke a step slowly, settled off the inside but never gained contention. ALL STORMY broke inwards bumping BLACK WING, was righted to track the leaders along the inside from out of striking distance racing to the turn but never gained contention. BLACK WING, bumped, then shuffled out of tight quarters at the start, settled near the inside but never menaced thereafter. DANCING LEAF tracked off the second flight three deep between foes racing to the turn and steadily faded from contention.
