Footnotes

PAPAW BODIE reserved off the second flight saving ground to the backstretch, shifted out four wide entering the second bend while steadily advancing to contention, continued in that path to upper stretch while being roused to challenge for command, continued in an extended skirmish past the furlong marker and narrowly prevailed on the wire under brisk right handed encouragement. TRIPLE CHECK, reserved between foes in the last flight in the opening stages, made steady progress to gain contention nearing the midway point of the far turn, shifted out five deep approaching the quarter mile marker while being roused to challenge, moved to terms with the leaders leaving midstretch and edged a rival for place honors on the wire while just missing the winner. CHALICE pulled his way to the a forward placing between foes from the outset, was held up off the first flight while shifting to the inside entering the first turn to stalk the leaders, shifted out midway through the second bend to split three deep, moved to challenge for command in tandem with the eventual winner in that path racing into the stretch, contested the issue to the wire and was just outnodded. FRIENDLY BANTER was roused to the fore from between foes, angled to the inside setting the pace on a narrow margin into the backstretch, held sway under pressure into upper stretch but yielded to the top trio nearing the sixteenth marker. MAVERICKING, reserved along the inside in the opening half, swung outside foes racing through the far turn to bid six wide in upper stretch and made some mild progress late. ROI LE ROY was settled in last racing to the far turn, swung out seven wide racing into the stretch but made no impression. SKIPPING THE SCORE settled off the second flight along the inside, saved ground on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch to bid between foes but lacked the needed final response. NOLANGRANT'SKITTEN, urged to secure a forward placing outside foes racing to the first turn, prompted the pacesetter racing into the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. PRESENTS FOR BERTI, pulling a bit tracking just off the leaders along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch but quickly came up empty. DANCE FOR PACO tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, made a brief, three wide bid midway through the far turn but quickly retreated nearing upper stretch.
