### Footnotes

BATITO was rated just off the second flight in the opening stages, shifted to the rail nearing the turn when presented an opening commencing a steady advance inside foes, shifted off the rail in upper stretch to challenge three deep for command leaving the furlong marker and wrested a clear advantage in time under firm encouragement. ROARIN MISSILE was urged to secure the lead while angling inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin through the bend, was urged to extend that advantage in upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner late. NORTHSCAPE angled inwards prompting the pacesetter from the outset, pressed the issue to upper stretch and gave way. GO GETEM tracked just off the leaders outside foes racing through the backstretch, lodged a brief, three wide bid nearing upper stretch but steadily faded after a half. ALL TANKED UP tracked just off the first flight a bit off the inside in the opening stages, switched out further racing into the bend and came up empty after a half.
