Footnotes

MALIBU VICE tracked just off the second flight under some reserve racing to the backstretch, split foes three wide racing through the far turn to gain terms with the first flight nearing midstretch and edged forward late under brisk handling. SPARSE settled off the inside in the opening half, gathered momentum leaving the far turn, angled six wide nearing midstretch and produced a solid final response to secure the place. CHOCTAW SMOKE settled along the inside in the opening half, made steady progress racing through the far turn to gain contention nearing upper stretch, angled five wide racing through the lane while drawing on terms with the winner but was outkicked. LEAD THE WAY tracked the pace between foes in the second flight to the far turn, bid between foes for command nearing upper stretch but was outfinished. TIO CHENCHO, reserved along the inside racing to the far turn, never gained striking distance. SNOWKIN' GUN tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out to challenge four wide entering upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. STEPFATHER was urged to secure the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, held sway on a clear margin to the second bend, dueled for command racing through the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch. COLE B tracked the pacesetter along the inside as part of the second flight but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. SLOW DOWN SONES was a brief factor racing three deep in the second flight but gave way after a half.
