Footnotes

DADE BABE moved well clear of her foes racing into the first turn, set the pace in hand while opening a commanding margin on the backstretch, held sway to upper stretch and was roused to maintain her advantage in the last furlong. LA CLOCHE tracked the pacesetter as part of the second flight just off the inside racing to the far turn, couldn't menace the winner but responded well enough to secure the place in late stages. SILENT CANDY angled inwards leading the second flight into the backstretch, made a brief advance to striking distance along the rail entering upper stretch but flattened out late. DUNDALK DUST was settled along the inside in the opening half, saved ground throughout and improved her position inside foes. MADDIE'S ODYSSEY tracked the pace between off the second flight, then continued evenly into the stretch. CAVE CREEKER was settled outside foes in early stages, was caught four wide racing through the far turn while under some pressure to advance but weakened nearing the stretch. MOURETTE tracked just off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. BESITOS was settled off the inside in the opening half, was fanned five wide racing into the stretch but made no impression on the leaders. KILMORE QUAY (IRE) broke outwards bumping at the start, was righted to track the pace three wide between foes off the second flight to the far turn but steadily faded from contention. DUE TO A TELETIMER MALFUNCTION THE RACE WAS HAND TIMED.
