Footnotes

DANI NIKKI was rated just out of striking distance between foes while shifting inwards a bit racing to the first turn, tracked off the first flight under reserve outside a rival for five furlongs, shifted out while moving to challenge four deep on her own courage nearing upper stretch, then produced a steady late response when called upon approaching the furlong marker to wrest command and draw clear late under firm encouragement. CHELAN ECHO, held up just off the first flight in the opening stages, switched out three deep on the backstretch while steadily moving to terms with the leaders after a half, moved to challenge in that path midway through the far turn, resisted the winner's bid past midstretch but proved no match in the last furlong. EMILY OSTROSKI angled inwards to track just off the first flight under light reserve in the opening half, shifted off the inside on the far turn to advance between foes racing into the stretch but lacked the needed final no kick. AULT STREET angled inwards in the opening stages while reserved between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out three deep on the far turn while under some prompting to challenge between rivals racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. PASSION DIRECTED settled saving ground in the last flight racing to the backstretch, dropped out to last nearing the far turn, swung out four wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders while gaining some position. ROSIE'S WILD TALE secured terms with a rival on the pace while under light rating attending that foe's pace racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid between foes to strike the front midway through the far turn but gave way nearing midstretch when failing to match the top pair. CARLI'S SONG was urged to secure the lead along the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend and gave way after six furlongs. SECRET VIOLET, caught three deep, then four wide racing to the backstretch tracking off the second flight, was fanned five wide leaving the midway point of the far turn and soon gave way.
