RICH CITY DUDE pressed the pace then was roused at the top of the stretch and dug in then drew clear. CANAVERAL RIDE set a pressured pace, battled to the lane then held place. RULER OF THE COURT was away awkwardly, rated in the second flight then made a late rally. MIAMI ICE flashed no speed, angled out and hit his best stride late. CLEW BAY was void of speed, had a rail trip and closed willingly. CANDY VAN rated in the middle of the pack, was asked between horses and ran evenly. GRAND ROW was unprepared at the start, was void of speed but made no rally. WILDWOOD WINNER was fractious behind the gate, had a rail trip but made no rally. ONE CLASSY OUTLAW raced close up between horses, was asked but made no rally. BOLD GENTLEMAN was fractious and ran off in the post parade, chased the pace then gave way.
