HOT CHA CHA had a rail trip then angled out and rallied while four wide on the turn and caught the leader late. ROMACACA pressed the pace and battled, led late and held place. SINGLE SOLUTION was void of speed and saved ground then made a late rally between horses. HAMEILDAEME (GB) was allowed to settle, angled out and closed willingly while five wide. C. S. SILK was well rated then was asked between horses but, faltered. PRYTANIA showed no speed, split horses in the lane and made a late rally. NAPOLEON'S RETREAT rated in the middle of the pack, was asked between horses and ran evenly. KISS MINE was rushed up and set a fast pace, led to the turn then tired. PEACH BREW dropped back along the inside, had a rail trip but was no factor. BILL'S PRESENCE rated in the second flight and chased to the lane then gave way. HUSTLE was void of speed then dropped back and was no factor. EMBERS GLOWING raced in the middle of the pack, contended to the turn then tired.
