Footnotes

GALAVANT was guided to the rail soon after the break while taking up a position just off the first flight, came through nearing the half mile marker to press the pace inside foes, dueled for command inside foes to upper stretch, then shook clear and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. FEISTY LOVE, on terms with the first flight between foes in the opening stages, dropped off the leaders nearing the turn while angling to the rail, then continued with a steady bid inside foes racing into the stretch to prove best of the others. LEMONDROPSRITZER joined the pace three deep in the opening stages, raced just off the first flight nearing the turn, moved to challenge in that path approaching upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. SPECIALAGENTNCHARG tracked off the first flight outside foes in the opening stages, shifted out five wide nearing upper stretch but lacked a closing bid. BUCKLE UP OUTLAW ducked in at the start, was held up in traffic along the inside in the opening stages, continued along the inside into the turn but lacked the needed closing response. ORPHANELLE, urged to dispute the pace between foes in the opening stages, pressed the pace to upper stretch and gave way. SHEGONNAWIN broke a bit awkwardly and never gained contention.
