Footnotes

MULATA, brushed at the start, was caught four wide in the opening stages while being reserved off the second flight racing into the first turn, continued outside foes from just out of striking distance to the second bend, made steady progress three, then four deep on the far turn to gain striking distance nearing upper stretch, then produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under energetic handling. LATIKA LOVE, bumped at the start while shifting into the path of the eventual winner, was quickly righted, then guided to the rail to gain a position just off the pacesetter saving ground, stalked the leader in that fashion racing into the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch while being roused to challenge, gained brief command leaving the furlong marker but couldn't fend off the winner's final bid. A. J.'S LOVE gained a position between in second flight in the opening stages, raced under reserve dropping back from that position while continuing between foes to the far turn, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly to late stages to gain some position while edging several rivals for a share. LET IT RAIN was settled in last while angling to the inside, saved ground throughout, then shifted off the rail in the last furlong while continuing in an even effort. TELMA moved to the fore soon after the break to dictate the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside, briefly resisted when challenged racing through the far turn to upper stretch but gave way leaving the furlong marker. FORTHELONGHAUL broke outwards bumping LATIKA LOVE, was righted, then urged to a position tracking the pacesetter three deep racing to the backstretch, continued under pressure to prompt the leader racing into the far turn but gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
