### Footnotes

GRAZIE bobbled a bit at the start, was urged to contest the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, gained the advantage in the second furlong while shifting to the inside, dictated the pace on a clear margin to the far turn, then continued in a game effort to turn back a challenge from BUDDYBDANCING racing into the stretch to edge clear again in late stages while fully extended nearing the wire. The latter, held up avoiding close quarters at the break, angled to the inside racing into the first turn, made steady progress while shifting outside the pacesetter to challenge that foe leaving the far turn but proved no match in the last furlong. MR NUM NUM settled outside foes racing to the first turn, angled to the inside while dropping into last on the backstretch, gained some position inside foes racing through the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. POWERSFIELD broke a step behind the leaders, was urged to challenge for command inside the pacesetter racing into the turn, ceded the lead to that foe before the opening quarter while shifting off the inside, steadily faded from contention after a half, then was carried out a bit racing into the stretch while dropping out. BRIM shifted off the inside early to track the leaders from out of striking distance and never mounted a serious challenge.
