Footnotes

UNCLE JEEP shifted off the rail in the opening stages gaining a position just off the first flight tracking those foes unhurried, made steady progress while shifting out three deep racing into upper stretch, moved to challenge for command nearing the furlong marker, gained the advantage and held safe the late bid of OUTLAW ZEN to the end under firm handling. The latter angled to the inside in the opening stages tracking the leaders from out of striking distance, commenced a steady advance on the turn while shifting off the inside, swung four wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly in that path to contest the issue to the end while proving only second best. HAPMAN tracked the leaders from out of striking distance outside a rival in the opening stages, continued evenly just off the inside racing through the bend, then shifted outside rivals in the final sixteenth while earning a share. LUCK WITH A KISS was prompted to join the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, forced the pace on the turn to midstretch but yielded in the final sixteenth. STATIC KILL broke slowly, was settled into stride along the inside, shifted out in upper stretch and displayed some belated interest. QUALITY DIPLOMAT sprinted to the lead while angling sharply to the rail, dueled for command inside a rival to upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. WILDWOOD HEIR was settled outside foes in the opening stages and soon trailed.
