J S P PALS FOREVER broke sharply, ceded the lead to a rival to track that foe while leading the second flight on a narrow margin a bit off the inside racing to the turn, came under pressure to advance midway through the bend, steadily drew on terms with the leader in upper stretch to gain the advantage approaching the furlong marker then drew clear late under firm right handed encouragement. RANSOM ZIP angled to the inside in early stages tracking the pace in second flight, saved ground to upper stretch, then shifted outside a tiring foe in late stages to prevail for place honors. JUDY MY DARLING was urged to the lead from the break, shifted to the rail dictating the pace racing into the bend, briefly resisted the winner's challenge but gave way leaving the furlong marker. MICHALINA tracked the pace three deep in second flight racing into the turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. SHES GOT TO RUN shifted off the inside early to track the pace between foes in the second flight, but came up empty nearing upper stretch. SIN BIN, under pressure to contend in early stages, was soon outpaced. BOB'S HILDA, unruly in the gate, was scratched by order of the stewards.
