Footnotes

TELL ALL YOU KNOW, in touch with the first flight between foes from the outset attending the pace under light rating, continued on terms with the leaders while being fanned three wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady late response to narrowly prevail following an extended skirmish. RADIANT DAY, reserved tracking off the first flight between foes from just out of striking distance racing to the turn, was urged through close quarters to challenge between foes just off the inside racing through upper stretch and contested the issue to the wire while just losing the nod. KIPLING'S KING moved to the fore along the inside to dispute the pace, dueled for command into upper stretch while shifting a bit off the rail, then grudgingly resisted the top pair while between those foes racing to the wire. STATIC KILL tracked just off the first flight outside foes in the opening stages, was urged to challenge while being fanned five wide into upper stretch and had no final kick. ISLE OF SKYE angled inwards to join the pace three deep in the opening stages, continued between foes while being fanned four wide into upper stretch and weakened late. WHAT DO YOU MEAN stalked just off the first flight along the inside racing into the turn, lodged a brief bid nearest the rail when presented an opening nearing upper stretch but gave way in late stages.
