FRANKLY MY DEAR set the pace from the inside while pressed, took a clear lead in the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. HUMBLE CLERK pressed the pace just outside and gained steadily late but missed. TASTE THE PASSION raced three wide, angled out five wide for the drive and rallied belatedly for a share. LAKENHEATH lacked speed and rallied mildly in the drive. APPLESOLUTELY raced five wide on the first turn, continued four wide to the stretch and weakened. ADAM'S TIME lacked speed and showed little. RODEO FAN was four wide on the first turn, raced close up and tired. LORRAINE saved ground but dropped back steadily.
