FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Nominations close Wednesday, August 29, 2007 with no fee. A supplementary nomination may be made at time of entry for \$500 which includes entry and starting fees. \$150 to enter and \$150 additional to start with \$45,000 Added of which 60% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights; 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 at a mile or over in 2007 allowed 2 lbs. Of \$35,000 once or \$28,000 twice at a mile or over in 2007, 4lbs. Of \$30,000 once or \$24,000 twice at a mile or over in 2007, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered) The field will be limited to 12 starters. Highweights preferred. Lifetime earnings will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Nominations Closed Wednesday, August 29, 2007 with 19. Lane 3. (If the management considers it inadvisable to run this race on the Turf Course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth).

DEMARCATION had a shoe fixed in the paddock, waited for room in the turn, split horses and was too late. KENTUCKY MAN saved ground, made a bid and hung in the stretch. GALLOPING HOME raced evenly and failed to menace while saving ground. PIRATE SAINT raced in the second flight, loomed a threat and was not good enough. SNOWBLIND FRIEND was taken back at the start and no factor. THE UNBELIEVABLE was through early and outrun. SCOTT'S TIME trailed and was far back in the stretch. RACE RUN IN LANE 4.
