Footnotes

BOOM DE YA DA angled inwards a bit to stalk just off the pacesetter four deep early, made a steady, three wide advance on the bend to challenge that foe nearing midstretch, took over in late stages and gamely held the challenge of DEACON PAPA PETE under firm handling. The latter, held up between foes in the opening stages near the inside racing in second flight, shifted out to split foes racing into upper stretch, challenged for command three deep in late stages and was narrowly outfinished. STRAITUPCASHHOMEY broke inwards bumping ADAM N TONY, was urged to the fore five deep in the opening stages, angled inwards on the bend to dictate the pace outside a rival to upper stretch and weakened once headed by the winner. SPEEDY KING, in close attendance to the pace between foes in the opening stages, raced unhurried saving ground on the bend, shifted out splitting foes racing through the stretch and made some mild progress late. RULEROUS, prominent between foes from the outset, tracked between foes in second flight, angled four wide racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. TOQUINHO tracked off the second flight from the inside racing to the bend, angled five wide entering upper stretch and continued evenly. SMOKE N ASPHALT, a bit unruly in the gate prior to the start, was briefly on terms with the second flight along the rail racing to the bend, dropped off those foes after the opening quarter, shifted out racing through the stretch but lacked the needed late response. LITTLE LUCK, forwardly placed between foes, stalked just off the pacesetter while angling to the inside on the turn and steadily faded after three furlongs. ADAM N TONY, bumped at the start, settled into stride, was fanned six wide entering upper stretch but offered no rally.
