Footnotes

SILVER MENACE tracked just off the leaders under light rating along the rail racing into the bend, shifted out with a sharp move at the quarter mile marker while moving to terms with the pacesetter, was roused to wrest command, then drew clear racing through the stretch under steady pressure. DISTINCT HONOR tracked unhurried off the second flight while angling to the inside, shifted off the inside to split foes in upper stretch and proved best of the others. WILDCAT COUNTRY was urged to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to upper stretch but weakened once headed by the winner. DANDYMAN tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight in the opening stages, angled four wide avoiding some traffic nearing upper stretch and finished evenly in late stages. SCOOTA PETE settled into stride off the inside in the opening half and never gained contention. DURANGO TANGO tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, was checked out of tight quarters leaving the quarter mile marker and lacked a closing response. SEARCH NO MORE angled inwards gaining terms with a rival on the pace, prompted that foe's tempo racing into the bend, then gave way in traffic racing into upper stretch.
