UPSELL broke outwards bumping SORROWFUL JONES, was steadied out of tight quarters just after the break, gained a position along the inside tracking just off the first flight racing into the bend, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch to challenge, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and held safe the challenge of SORROWFUL JONES to the end under firm right handed encouragement. The latter, bumped at the start, was settled off the second flight near the inside racing into the turn, gathered momentum while angling out four wide in upper stretch and made steady late progress to close the gap. STIG'S DEPUTY broke sharply, attended a rival's pace in the opening stages, dispatched that foe racing into the turn while shifting nearer to the inside, briefly resisted the winner's challenge but weakened once headed by that foe leaving midstretch. BLACK CROSS tracked just off the leaders racing four wide into the turn, continued in that path to upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. FLYING ACT was hustled to dispute the pace along the inside racing into the turn but was spent early. CROOK'S BODGIT broke slowly losing position to the field and never menaced thereafter.
