SHE'S ON PARADE, a bit reluctant to load in the gate, was prompted between foes in the second flight to pursue the pacesetter into the turn, continued with a steady response while shifting outside the leader leaving midstretch to wrest command nearing the sixteenth marker and drew clear late under firm encouragement. SHE'S LIT UP broke inwards bumping HOLY ROSIE, was quickly righted then sprinted clear racing into the turn to open a commanding advantage, drifted out under pressure while being roused to resist the winner's challenge leaving the furlong marker but proved no match. GREAT RED BEAUTY, urged along four wide in the second flight racing into the bend, was a bit rank when resisting her rider's attempt to rate her speed entering the bend, then continued four deep into the stretch while finishing willingly for a share. ST. LOUIE SLEW broke inwards, was held up off the second flight while angling to the inside racing into the bend, shifted out to split foes in upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. QUEEN OF MONGOLIA broke slowly losing position to the field, shifted out racing into upper stretch and displayed some belated interest. THREE D vied three deep between foes as part of the second flight racing into the turn, couldn't maintain that position after a half and gave way in upper stretch. HOLY ROSIE, bumped at the start, quickly recovered, was urged to contend inside foes in the second flight chasing the pacesetter into the turn but gave way abruptly entering upper stretch.
