### Footnotes

ARRESTED BY DUFFY was rated out of striking distance along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted outside a rival after the opening quarter to track the leaders as part of the second flight, made steady progress while shifting out four deep on the far turn to gain striking position, shifted in nearing upper stretch to engage a rival for command, then took over in the final furlong to prove best under firm encouragement. RED LITE NITE joined the pace three deep from the outset, pressed the issue outside a rival into the far turn to gain the advantage after six furlongs, briefly resisted the winner's bid racing into upper stretch but came up second best. ANCIENT EYES tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance along the inside as part of the second flight in the opening half, shifted out splitting foes three deep on the far turn, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and continued well enough to earn a share. IT'SALLABOUTRED broke slowly, was settled in last to the backstretch, shifted outside foes racing through the far turn, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and gained some position late while making no impression on the leaders. AIN'T NO SAINT tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening half, was urged to advance while caught five wide racing into the far turn to lodge a brief bid but quickly came up empty nearing upper stretch. BEACH CLUB, urged to dispute the pace inside foes nearest the rail, was eased off the leaders to track those foes through the backstretch, shifted out entering the far turn to make a second challenge three deep between foes but gave way abruptly entering upper stretch. ZAP'EM was urged to secure the lead between foes racing into the first turn, dueled between foes while gaining a narrow margin racing to the backstretch, continued to dispute the issue inside a rival to the second bend and gave way midway through the far turn.
