### Footnotes

JOHN GALT broke outwards, was urged to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight tracking the leaders, made steady progress three deep on the turn to gain striking position racing into upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and pulled clear late under firm handling. CLYDE BANK shied outwards at the start bumping FAMILY SIX, was quickly righted, then urged between foes to dispute the pace racing into the turn, dueled for command inside a rival while shifting to the rail racing through the turn, edged forward to a narrow advantage in upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner's bid. FAMILY SIX, bumped, then steadied sharply out of tight quarters at the start, settled into stride a bit off the inside racing into the turn, swung out five wide in upper stretch and made some belated progress. TRICKEROY joined the pace three deep soon after the start, forced the issue outside a rival on the turn to upper stretch and gave way. GEORGIE MY BOY was urged to dispute the pace from the outset along the inside, eased back off the first flight entering the turn to track those foes along the rail but steadily faded racing through the stretch. KELPIE tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight, lost some position behind GEORGIE MY BOY racing into the bend, shifted out on the turn while being urged to advance between foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. QUIET REBEL tracked off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, shifted outside foes on the turn, raced four wide entering upper stretch but offered no rally. STERLING CROWN broke slowly, quickly lost contact with the field, was pulled up by his rider, then was vanned off the course.
