Footnotes

BERNT TO RUN broke sharply, dictated the pace outside a rival on a narrow margin racing into the turn, shook clear nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. ISLAND MISS tracked the leaders off the inside from just out of striking distance early, angled out four wide nearing upper stretch to challenge, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. MUDDY GATOR was settled outside a rival racing to the bend, gradually drew on terms with the second flight entering upper stretch, angled five wide in late stages and continued well enough to earn a share. ULTIMATE EVENT was settled along the inside in the opening quarter, saved ground to upper stretch, then shifted out to split foes with a belated effort. MICHALINA tracked just off the first flight in the opening stages, split foes racing through the turn while under some pressure to gain striking distance but flattened out in upper stretch. HIWAY SIXTY WEST was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the bend and gave way after a half when proving no match. CHECK MY DADDY, in close attendance to the pace three deep early, tracked the pacesetter into upper stretch and steadily faded from contention.
