Footnotes

DELAGO, urged to secure a position just off the first flight in the opening stages, tracked the leaders under rating racing into the bend, shifted out to split foes in upper stretch and responded to firm handling to wrest command and pull clear in late stages. TERRIFIC TIM, urged between foes disputing the pace in the opening half, edged away to a clear advantage racing into upper stretch but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. PRIDEINYOUREYES raced unhurried along the inside from out of striking distance to the turn, gained some position inside foes on the bend, angled out four wide entering upper stretch and continued with a mild bid while gaining a share. GRAND COMPOSER settled outside foes in the opening stages, made some progress while angling out five wide in upper stretch and improved his position to the end. BIGTIME MAC, prominent outside foes in the opening stages, pressed the pace three deep racing into the turn to upper stretch and gave way. GRASS BLADE shifted off the inside pursuing the leaders racing

into the turn but offered no closing bid. JAUN DE LA PLAYA angled to the rail while being prompted to join the pace in the opening stages, pressed the issue inside foes racing into the turn and gave way. IKE'S BOY, bumped at the start, was settled along the inside, saved ground on the bend but never menaced. A NICE SLEWISH BOY settled in hand racing four wide between foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. CHEROKEECHALLENGER settled between foes in the opening stages and never seriously menaced. BIG POPPA D broke outwards bumping IKE'S BOY, was collected off that foe and soon trailed.
