Footnotes

BLUE FORTY, forwardly placed inside foes in the opening stages, shifted outside the pacesetter nearing the bend stalking that rival in hand, moved to wrest command nearing upper stretch, forged clear entering the straight and held sway on a clear margin to the end under firm right handed encouragement. CLASS BREAK hopped at the start, was pinched back when bumped from both sides at the break, settled into stride along the inside in last racing to the turn, shifted out while gathering momentum entering upper stretch to race in the four path and continued with interest to prove best of the others. CANTAFFORDANOTHER tracked just off the leaders along the inside in the opening stages, angled out entering upper stretch while being roused to challenge but lacked the needed final bid. LYDIA'S ANGEL broke sharply, was a brief factor outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn but steadily faded after a half. SHES DOWN WITH JIM broke inwards bumping CLASS BREAK, was urged to secure the lead from between foes while angling sharply to the inside in the opening furlong, set the pace along the rail racing into the turn but was spent after a half. BEYYA broke outwards bumping CLASS BREAK, was righted to track off the second flight near the inside early but soon dropped out of contention.
