ITZACOLDCASE secured a position just off the leaders along the inside while under light rating in the opening stages, saved ground on the bend, shifted off the inside to split foes leaving the furlong marker while bidding for command inside the pacesetter and just edged that foe in the final strides under firm handling. OUR GIRL MAGIC broke readily, attended a rival's pace racing to the bend under light reserve, moved to wrest command entering upper stretch, held sway past the furlong marker but couldn't contain the winner. SILKY SAMI was settled off the second flight along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out nearing midstretch while producing her best response and made some solid progress while shifting out of close quarters in the final stages to narrowly prevail for a share. UPTOWN BABE broke slowly, settled off the inside, split foes entering upper stretch and made some belated progress to improve position. ZIPPING AWAY, forwardly placed three deep in the opening stages, tracked the leaders as part of the second flight in that path racing to upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. STIVERS SUPRISE was urged to the lead from between foes while angling to the inside, set the pace on a narrow margin to upper stretch and gave way nearing the furlong marker. DE LICA tracked off the second flight off the inside racing to the turn, angled out five wide in upper stretch and steadily faded in the drive.
