Footnotes

TAJAAWEED was settled into a comfortable stride along the inside in the opening half, shifted off the inside entering the far turn gathering momentum, switched out six deep entering upper stretch while moving readily to striking distance, asserted himself leaving the furlong marker to wrest command and drew away late under a few right handed taps and a steady flourish of his rider's whip. TAZZ gained a position off the first flight racing just out of striking distance while angling to the inside, continued in that position into the second bend, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted out to split foes advancing in close quarters leaving the furlong marker but continued with interest to edge a rival for place honors. CROSS VILLAGE, held up well off the second flight near the inside in the opening six furlongs, angled out to advance five deep nearing the furlong marker and was just outfinished for second. SUNTRACER, reserved outside a rival in the opening half, was urged to advance four deep racing through the far turn to challenge for command entering upper stretch, struck the front approaching the furlong marker but failed to sustain his momentum. LEGENDARY KING, held up from just out of striking distance racing as part of the second flight in the opening stages, advanced to challenge the leaders racing three deep through the far turn but lacked the needed final response. COOL C NOTE angled inwards while being urged to gain terms with a rival on the pace, attended that foe's tempo for a half, pressed the issue between foes racing through the far turn to upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. EXCHANGING KISSES moved to the fore along the inside in the opening stages to dictate the pace on a narrow margin, disputed the lead racing through the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch.
