Footnotes

CATCH THAT KITTEN, forwardly placed along the inside from the break, attended a rival's pace racing into the backstretch, relinquished the lead to that foe after a half, shifted out to challenge for command entering the far turn, took over and went clear, widening her advantage to the end under pressure. POINT YOUR FINGER, brushed at the break, secured a tracking position just off the first flight racing to the backstretch, bid outside the eventual winner racing through the far turn but couldn't gain terms with that foe while proving best of the others. LITTLE FRANCES tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight to the backstretch, continued three deep through the second bend and edged a rival for a share while never menacing the top pair. WHYS MISS broke outwards, bumped NO RETREAT, was righted while gaining position in midpack, worked her way to the rail entering the backstretch, shifted out on the far turn to bid between foes but came up empty nearing upper stretch. THUNDERING BROOK, shuffled a bit in close quarters just after the start, continued evenly just off the inside racing into the stretch. WILDCAT MISS broke inwards brushing a rival, was urged to join the pace outside the eventual winner racing into the first turn, pressed the issue for a half, continued to make the pace into the far turn but gave way once headed by the winner. CANYON SHADOWS settled along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground throughout and never gained contention. TAKE MANHATTAN tracked the leaders along the inside but dropped out after a half. NO RETREAT, bumped at the start, recovered to be a brief factor outside foes racing into the backstretch but dropped out entering the far turn.
