Footnotes

CALL TO GLORY moved to the fore between foes in the opening quarter, edged clear after a half while angling inwards a bit, held sway on a narrow margin into upper stretch, then turned back a challenge from ULTIMATE DECISION to prove best under firm handling. PERJURY tracked the leaders along the inside under some reserve racing off the second flight in the opening stages, angled off the inside bumping JOE BOYD entering upper stretch but continued well to close the gap on the winner racing three deep between foes. ULTIMATE DECISION stalked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing to the turn, bid inside that foe along the rail entering upper stretch to strike the front near the furlong marker but was outkicked. INCLUDING WARDO settled between foes three deep racing to the bend, made some progress inside foes nearing upper stretch, shifted out sharply nearing midstretch to challenge five deep and continued with a mild gain. RESCUE FINANCING, forwardly placed three wide in the opening half, made a brief bid in that patch racing into upper stretch but flattened out in the last furlong. JOE BOYD tracked off the second flight between foes racing into the turn, was carried out entering upper stretch and had no rally. DREAMING OF LES, reserved four wide off the second flight racing to the turn, continued outside foes but never gained contention. PERFECT BROTHER, urged to contend racing four wide into the bend, dropped out nearing upper stretch.
