ROMIN ROBIN gained a tracking position outside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch while under some reserve, moved to striking distance while angling three deep entering upper stretch, then wrested command and edged forward leaving the furlong marker under firm handling. CLOSEOUT reserved off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening half, made steady progress shifting outside foes leaving the far turn, angled four deep nearing midstretch and continued well to close the gap on the winner late while never quite gaining even terms with that foe. HAPPINESS IS, forwardly placed outside a rival racing to the backstretch, attended that foe's pace to the far turn, pressed the issue into upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the top pair late but continued well enough to hold for a share. PATHWAY moved to the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace inside a rival on a narrow margin racing to the second bend, dueled with that foe into upper stretch and gave out in late stages. SOUPER MISS broke inwards brushing SINGLE SOLUTION, was settled along the inside in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn to split foes racing into the stretch but made no impression on the leaders. SINGLE SOLUTION, off a step slowly, then brushed at the start, continued unhurried outside foes to the far turn, advanced in tandem with SOUPER MISS while angling five wide entering upper stretch and continued evenly in late stages. VIVA VINO angled inwards to track just off the first flight along the inside racing to the far turn but steadily retreated in the drive. CHORAGUS was a brief factor inside foes racing to the backstretch but dropped out of contention after a half.
